Members of the club have kindly been invited to visit Astley and Tyldesley Cycle Speedway Club in May for an exclusive coaching session. Coach Mike Hack will be giving up his time at the Gin Pit Circuit, Astley and Tyldesley Miners Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Astley, M29 7DW.
